Community Services Foundation/Community Enhancement Fund Grant Advisory Committee

The purpose of the Committee is to review grants and make recommendations to the Boards. The Foundation/Fund enhances services and resources to the community through the sponsorship of programs, activities, special events, and schools in and around Sienna.

Finance Advisory Committee

The role of the Finance Advisory Committee is to provide expertise and recommendations to the Board on financial matters and in planning a program of asset management for the Sienna Associations.



Hearing Advisory Committee

This Committee is responsible for holding hearings for members to determine if fines should be imposed for deed restriction violations or privileges held for lack of assessment payment.

Landscape Committee

The Landscape Committee provides information to the community about lawn care and plants.

- ◆ Assists in development of entry and cul-de-sac renovation plans
- ◆ Hosts a spring and fall flower and mulch sale
- ◆ Yard of the Month judging throughout the year and Holiday Décor judging in the winter season



Modifications Committee

The Modifications Committee meets to approve or disapprove modifications, additions, or alterations made on or to the residences and other improvements on lots. They also develop guidelines for modifications, using the Builder Guidelines as a primary source, for recommendations to the Boards of Directors.

Committee Overview



Information Technology (IT) Task Force

The Information Technology (IT) Task Force shall analyze the Associations' technology infrastructure and systems to evaluate the benefit of having an external audit. If the Task Force determines there is a benefit to an external IT audit, Task Force members would then participate in the process.

Sienna CARES/Welcome Campaign

The purpose of the Sienna CARES campaign is to foster and maintain Sienna's small-town atmosphere. This committee is comprised of CARES Captains who work with staff to develop and implement neighborhood activities and socials designed to promote neighborhood awareness and communications (as needed)

Via US mail, new Sienna residents receive a packet full of useful and important information including welcome material detailing the Association's role and its employees, community activities, volunteer committees, and important numbers to call. Residents may also view a Welcome Video online at Siennanet for an overview of the Association's role and the community as a whole.



Special Events Task Force

The Special Events Task Force assists staff in implementing events that bring the community together as a whole. Such events may include, but are not limited to:

- ◆ Teen Events
- ◆ Gingerbread Market
- ◆ Snow Blast

Village Representatives (Reps)

Each of the seven Villages located within Sienna have one or more Village Reps who are elected by the members. The Village Rep role is to:

- ◆ Provide communications to and from neighbors to the Associations, Staff and the Board of Directors
- ◆ Upon request from the Developer, provide input on commercial ARC matters
