






Sienna Ranch Road/Fort Bend Tollway Work

The Fort Bend County Toll Road Authority has notified the Association that **beginning on  Wednesday, May 20 through  Wednesday, May 27**, lane closures will be in effect on Sienna Ranch Road due to construction work on the Fort Bend Toll Road expansion. Signage will be in place to alert drivers, but please be aware that the closures will impact traffic flow/speed .

Additionally, residents are reminded that sidewalk closures are in place. Heavy equipment is moving in to allow construction on bridge foundations and ignoring closures is dangerous. Please follow instructions and use the sidewalk on the opposite side of the street. The sooner crews can complete the work, the sooner the sidewalk can reopen.
