



### **Road Work News**

Sienna Parkway at Steep Bank Trace: The City of Missouri City has notified the Association that road work on a portion of **Sienna Parkway southbound, just before Steep Bank Trace, will begin on Monday, June 15 and continue through Thursday, June 18** (dependent on weather). This project requires lane closure and replacement of a concrete panel. Contractors have installed “Road Work” signs in preparation and residents can anticipate delays.

Sienna Parkway at McKeever/GCWA Canal: The lane widening project over the GCWA canal is anticipated to begin within the next 2 weeks. Fort Bend County anticipates that the overall project will take approximately one year. These specific (smaller section) projects are important to any future long-term Sienna Parkway mobility changes. The Association will share further updates with residents as they are received.
