



### **Road Work Updates**

Sienna Parkway at McKeever/GCWA Canal: The lane widening project over the GCWA canal will begin this week on Thursday, July 2. Fort Bend County anticipates that the overall project will take approximately one year. Staff are in contact with the project engineer and will provide updates as they are received.

### **Pool Access Refinements**

Due to recent challenges at the pools, every resident/family member 10 years and up should be prepared to scan and show their Amenity Access Credential or Sienna ID card to gate guards at the pools. As per policy, each household is allowed to bring 5 guests per visit, but residents will now need to sign in guests at the gate and as always, must remain with their guests. Sienna youth, ages 10 – 21 years who are coming to the pool on their own, may only bring in one (1) guest – which will be enforced stringently. Guests must remain with their resident host and must leave the pool when the resident leaves. Sharing of Access Credentials (or cards) among family members, neighbors or guests is not allowed, and anyone caught doing so may have their access suspended. The signing in of guests and scanning/review of each Credential or ID may delay entry to the pool and residents are asked to be patient. All Access Credentials must be preapproved and residency verified before they become active and ready for use. Approval can take up to 72 hours and is dependent on resident profile and account information on file at the Association. Do not wait until you are leaving for the pool to download your Sienna App. Residents who have an active Access Credential, but who have not uploaded a personal photo to their Credential must do so..
